NAMING OF FILES FOR CORENET'S E-SUBMISSION

Please refer to our circular CD/FSSD/12/01/03/04, - Naming of Files for CORENET's e-submission, dated 19 September 2005. In the circular, we highlighted that all CAD files shall be named in accordance with SS CP 83: 2001 "Construction Computer-aided Design (CAD)". Please see Annex A for the extract of the circular.

2. Despite the circular issued in 2005, there has not been any improvement in file naming for plans that were submitted. Many plans that were submitted to us via CORENET's e-submission are still not in conformance with the SS CP 83: 2001. This has resulted in our officers encountering difficulty in searching for the relevant files during audit check, processing of plan approval and waiver applications.

3. We would therefore like to remind QPs to use SS CP 83: Part 3: 2001, "Organising and naming of CAD Files." as the guide in naming files and documents when submitting them to FSSD via CORENET's e-submission. Please see Annex B for an example.

4. With effect from 1 January 2012, applications with plans that are not in conformance with CP 83: Part 3: 2001 will be rejected. Please be reminded that the fees paid will not be refunded for rejected applications.
